Year 13 HE applications

Year 13 students who are planning to progress onto HE or FE colleges after Sixth form are now starting to focus on submitting their UCAS applications. Year 13 UCAS Target grades

These are now available on the Portal for MSN Sixth students and paper copies have been given to students based at the Writhlington Sixth Campus. These are the grades which will be used on references and UCAS applications for students this year. These are based on students' attainment over the courses so far and are considered to be the most optimistic outcomes for students at this stage. Super-curricular website

Our new super-curricular website has been created to support our students with their next steps.
